Who can participate in the tournaments?

Players who are members of any National Bridge Organisation outside Norway can participate in all open tournaments in the festival if they pay the starting fee.

The National Pairs Championship is a closed event.

Only member of a Norwegian club who have payed their membership fees and their players licenses before the start of the Swiss pairs tournament may qualify for the closed Pairs Championship. For international players this can be arranged at Lillehammer.

Summary: Non-norwegian players pay the starting fee, if they want to try to qualify to National Pairs from the Swiss Pairs there is an extra fee of approximately 70 Euro pr. player paid before the Swiss pairs start.
